<b>Content</b> Did the presentation cover the specified information on the discovery?	Presentation did not follow the guidelines on information to be provided. <b>Collaboration</b> Did everyone contribute to the presentation and seem well versed?	The team did not cohesively and coherently present the necessary information.
