Trivia Crack Question Writing Instructions:

Each Friday indicated on the syllabus you will submit TWO trivia crack questions with 4 possible multiple-choice answers.

Each question is from the material that was covered during that week.



Questions can cover any of the assigned readings (that were covered in class) our notes and required (not suggested) readings or links. Definitions are appropriate as are basic and moderately complex questions that come from the assigned materials. Only include relevant information in your question. Avoid negative questions when possible (which is not true or all of the following are incorrect except...).

Each question must come with four multiple-choice answers. Indicate the correct answer with an asterisk (*) at the end of the question.

To get credit for your submission the question must be appropriate and not poorly written or unclear. Answers that only have one obvious correct response and three clearly incorrect responses will not earn points. The incorrect responses (also known as distractors) should be written in a way that might be selected by students who did not read or learn the material and would be ignored by students who learned the material. Ensure that only ONE answer is correct and another possible answer is correct in a different condition. A possibly correct (for a different question) is an appropriate distractor.

If you are looking for more insight into how to write a good multiple choice question, there are plenty of university websites on google that will help.

Question submission: One document for BOTH questions. Include your last name in the name of the document and on the FIRST line of the word document. Submit your question on blackboard by 11:50 pm each of the indicated Fridays.
