

Bio for Stephen J. Conroy, Ph.D.

Stephen Conroy is a Professor of Economics at the University of San Diego, where he joined the faculty in 2004. Dr. Conroy also served as the Associate Dean of Undergraduate Business Programs (2015 – 2021) and the Faculty Director of the Center for Peace of Commerce (2012 – 2015). He earned a Ph.D. (1998) and M.A. (1995) in Economics from the University of Southern California and a B.A. in Economics from Creighton University, where he graduated with honors in 1987.

Dr. Conroy has published over 24 journal articles and book chapters with more than 2,000 citations in Google Scholar, primarily in the areas of applied microeconomics, housing economics, business ethics, economics of education and economics of aging. Dr. Conroy enjoys collaborating and mentoring in research, including supervising undergraduate Honors theses, teaching the senior seminar (capstone) course in Economics and coauthoring peer-reviewed journal articles with four former undergraduate students.

Honored as a *Poets&Quants' Top 50 Undergraduate Business Professors in the U.S.* in 2018, Dr. Conroy has also won several research and teaching awards including being named Professor of the Year (*Mens et Spiritus* Award) from the USD Honors Program, (2015), Professor of Impact in 2016 (CC MBA Program), “Outstanding Professor Award” (2008 MBA Cohort), Senior Faculty Research Award (2014) and a Dual Excellence Award for outstanding teaching and research (2010). He has also been named both a Research Fellow (2016) and a Teaching Fellow (2020) of the Academy of Economics and Finance.
