

Instructions:

- 1) Choose three problems total over the three exams. Choose ones where you lost the most points (up to 6 points).
- 2) Clearly state, which problem you are doing, which exam it is from, and what your score was on the problem (adding up all the parts for that question).
- 3) Redo the entire problems (not just the parts you missed).
- 4) For full points back (up to 6) you need to do a good job. So show all your steps, make sure that you use good notation and are clear. To get full points you will need to do a better job than to get full credit on the original exam, since I know on the exams you are under time pressure and so I allow for disorganized work, but this should be neat and clear. This will not only help you get points on this assignment it will help you understand the material better for the final.
- 5) Remember this is part of your final study time. So don't just copy a correct solution, try to see if you can figure it out on your own or at least find out what you don't understand so that you can get help in a productive way.
