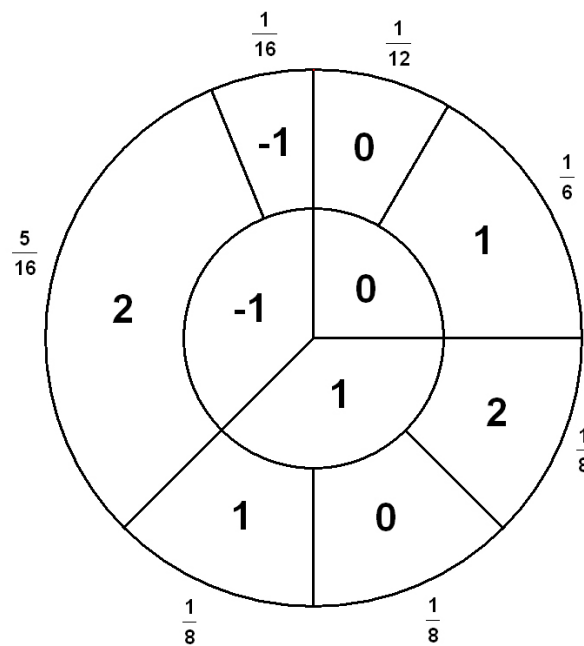


1. Suppose  $d = \gcd(32747, 73590)$ .

  - (b) Find  $k, l$  such that  $d = 32747 \cdot k + 73590 \cdot l$ .
2. For each of the following find  $a^{-1} \pmod{m}$  or explain why no such inverse exists. That is, find  $c$  such that  $ac \equiv 1 \pmod{m}$ .
  - (a)  $a = 533, m = 124229$
  - (b)  $a = 5213, m = 20709$ .

  - (c)  $E(Z)$
  - (d) Which is bigger  $P(X > 0.5)$  or  $P(Z > 0.5)$ ? Explain.
