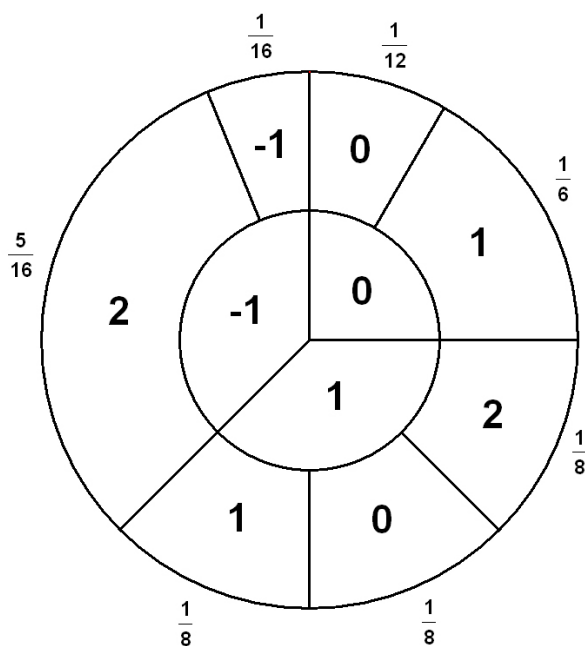


1. Suppose $d = \gcd(19578, 59712)$.
