

1. Encipher the message: "Who says nothing is impossible? I've been doing nothing for years." using a Caesar Cipher with key letter 'o'. Remember to remove all non-letters. Break up the letters into blocks of 4.
2. You intercept the message

TWZ GPS FXL YTE JMF ETS LEP APZ AWP.

Recover the plain text with out any knowledge of the key or what the message may contain. You do however have reason to believe that it was enciphered with a Caesar Cipher.
