

Student Presentation Instructions and Checklist

Two or three students will present a topic or technique and a paper relevant to the material being covered at that time (as per the syllabus). IF a group would like to cover a different topic the request of what and why must be requested well in advance.

The presentation must include all team members equally in time and difficulty of material presented. How this is done is up to the group.

20-30% of the presentation is to be at a wiki/google level and covers a basic concept of the material about to be presented or one or two important and interesting techniques the paper will use.

70-80% of the presentation will be an in depth presentation of either a scientific biochemistry related paper on cancer or a presentation of a review paper on a cancer topic. The topic should come from the material on the syllabus presented the week prior to your presentation. This is to be an in-depth, detailed presentation.

Instructor Review Check.

- A minimum of two weeks prior to the presentation the group **MUST** email the instructor the topic to be presented (both level 1 and 2), a copy (PDF) of the paper or review to be used for approval. (5 points)
- One week prior to the presentation a **DETAILED** outline of the presentation must be submitted to the instructor (5 points)

Peer Evaluation

Fill out one Peer Review form for each presentation (see form on class webpage). You will not get points if you do not fill out and turn this in. Each group member will submit the peer evaluation the day of the presentation.
