Janet Beronio is currently Senior Vice President and General Manager of Harrah's Rincon Casino & Resort. Prior to joining Harrah's, Beronio was a Deputy Attorney General for the State of Nevada, serving in both the Criminal and Civil Divisions. She began her career with Harrah's in 1984 as Associate General Counsel where her responsibilities included handling legal, governmental, and risk management affairs for Harrah's gaming properties in northern Nevada. In 1994, she was named Vice President and General Manager for Harrah's Phoenix Ak-Chin, the company's first Indian gaming property, and led the property through nine successive years of growth. In 2003, Beronio accepted the position of Senior Vice President and General Manager of Harrah's Rincon Casino & Resort, and in 2004 oversaw the construction and grand opening of the resort's \$168 million expansion.

Beronio also serves as first vice president of the Board of Directors for the Angels Depot and as a board member for the San Diego North Convention and Visitors Bureau. She is a recipient of the North County Philanthropy Council's Volunteer Award, Casino Enterprise Management magazine's Great Women of Gaming award and the San Diego Business Journal's Women Who Mean Business award. Earlier this year, she was named Chairwoman of the Harrah's Foundation.

She received her Bachelor of Arts Degree in Political Science from the University of Maryland and her Juris Doctorate from the University of San Diego. She is licensed to practice law in California, Colorado and Nevada.
